6. The punishment of suspension or expulsion shall remain deferred so long as the student meets the conditions

of the probation.

- 7. By signing this agreement, the student understands it shall be a Level III offense for a pupil placed on probation to willfully violate any term of the probationary agreement or any published USD 501 regulation for pupil conduct during the term of the probation. If the probation contract is broken, the pupil on probation retains the right to a hearing that complies with due process as set forth in the Suspension and Expulsion of Pupil Act, but only on the question of whether he/she violated the terms of probation. The student further understands that additional days of suspension or expulsion may be imposed only if the student's conduct violates additional provisions of the code of student conduct.
- 8. By signing this agreement the student agrees that the terms and conditions of this agreement have been explained to him or her and that s/he understands the conditions. The student further agrees to abide by the conditions set forth in the agreement and understands that failure to abide by the conditions may result in imposition of the original punishment.

B. Parent agrees and acknowledges:

- 1. That the student and parent had a right to challenge the proposed suspension or expulsion through a due process hearing, but has knowingly and voluntarily chosen to return to school under the terms and conditions set forth in this probation contract and waive the right to a due process hearing.
- 2. That the originally proposed suspension or expulsion may be imposed if the student fails to meet the terms and conditions of this probation.
