<u>It is important to note:</u> the coach of the student athlete must either be a member of the KBCA or have joined the <u>organization prior to recommending their player</u>. The applicant must be a member of their basketball team during their senior season and earn a varsity letter in that year. Please provide a current applicant picture with this application.

The following criteria will be the base of the Hill family's decision on who is chosen for the scholarship award:

ACADEMIC POTENTIAL

- a. GPA (all semesters except for final)
- b. Rank in class in accordance to class enrollment at time of application
- c. Test results (either ACT or SAT)

BASKETBALL RELATED ACTIVITIES

- a. Honors won (varsity letters earned, all conference, all state, etc.)
- b. Individual statistics as a varsity player
- c. Coaches Letter of Recommendation (Required in separate letter form with application)

SCHOOL LEADERSHIP QUALITIES

- a. Participation in non-sport school activities, offices held, etc.
- b. One Letter of Recommendation (Required in separate letter form from either School Administrator, Counselor, Teacher, Athletic Director, etc.)

COMMUNITY SERVICE

- a. Honors
- b. Community Activity, i.e. involvement in community service and religious involvement
- c. One Letter of Recommendation from Community Member (Required in separate letter form with application)
